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Student Experience

Academic Activities

- 6 classes of 60mins each in length per subject (up to 6 subjects)
- One-on-one tutoring everyday during program hours, including 4 hours of dedicated one-on-one tutoring blocks
- 2-3 recorded subject seminars for the most popular subjects
- Subject Booklets of up to 40 pages per subject provided
- Welcome Pack with school supplies equivalent to \$60 in value

Extracurricular Activities

- Daily 30min homeroom meetings in the same group everyday
- Daily publication and end-of-program yearbook produced by our Communications Team to foster strong sense of belonging
- 3 major social events (Incredible Race, BBQ and Trivia), including a program-wide competition; in 2025, called "The Jurassic Cup"
- Additional informal activities to unwind from academic content: Arts & Crafts, Book Club, Campus Tour and UNO Tournament

- Study Experience Panels: Medicine, Biomedicine, Science, Engineering, Allied Health, Psychology, Law, Business and Commerce, Arts and Humanities, Fine Arts, Music and Education
- Seminars: Study Skills, Job Skills, Moving out of Home, 10 Things I Wish I Knew Before University
- Extracurricular Interest Workshops: Industry Skills (CAS Calculator Hacks, Programming), Dance (Hip-Hop, Tap), Language 101s (Ancient Egyptian, Hindi, Italian, Korean, Turkish)

Our daily schedule is designed to facilitate strong study-life balance, which helps reduce fatigue during the program and maximise value for students.

Our holistic timetable composition also allows us to offer students the broadest possible range of preparatory activities.

In 2025, for a \$150 fee, this was the equivalent of **\$2 an hour per activity, or <\$5 per hour of tutoring; 10x-30x lower than common private tutoring rates.**
