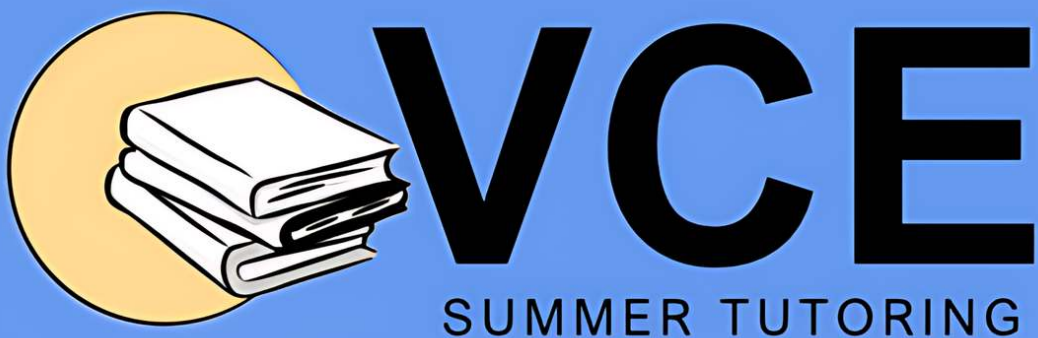




VCE Summer Tutoring is a youth-led, volunteer-run charity established to ensure high school students from a diverse range of backgrounds across Victoria can access a high quality education.

Student Experience

Academic Activities

- 6 classes of 60mins each in length per subject (up to 6 subjects)
- One-on-one tutoring everyday during program hours, including 6 hours of dedicated guided private study tutoring blocks
- Subject Booklets of up to 40 pages per subject provided
- Welcome Pack with school supplies and merchandise

Extracurricular Activities

- Daily 30min homeroom meetings in the same student groups
- Daily publication and end-of-program yearbook produced by our Communications Team to foster strong sense of belonging
- 3 major social events (Incredible Race, BBQ and Trivia), including a program-wide competition; in 2026, called "The Pasta Bowl"
- Additional informal activities to unwind from academic content: Arts & Crafts, Book Club, Campus Tour and UNO Tournament

Our daily schedule is designed to facilitate strong study-life balance, which keeps students energised during the program and maximises its value.

Our holistic timetable composition also allows us to offer students the broadest possible range of preparatory activities for VCE.

In 2026, the Program fee was \$180. 19.6% of students received bursaries to attend the program.

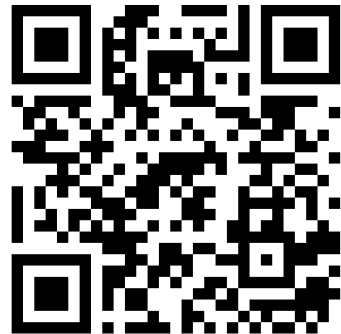
